

## Our Achievements

- Vision Youth is one of the most recognized and successful youth leadership programs conducted completely by volunteers in the Greater Toronto Area.
- With the help of 80 youth counsellors, the program has successfully trained over 1000 Visioneers, aged 14 to 18, with an average of over 90 participants every year.
- Vision Youth has been recognized by The Duke of Edinburgh's Award as the organization with the highest percentage of achievers in Ontario since 2004.
- Vision Youth has participated in the Social Innovation and Global Citizenship program, along with the University of Toronto, and has received interns from the University of Hong Kong since 2011.

- Vision Youth co-organized the annual youth career forum, "Kickstart to a New Career", with the Pui Ching Alumni Association (Ontario) and Deputy Mayor Godwin Chan. The forum attracted more than 400 youth and parents every year to attend the full afternoon session.
